

Little Red Riding Hood Word Search



Test your pupils' observation and reading skills in this fun activity, linking back to Traditional Tales!

Year Group: Year 3 / P4

Outcome: Opportunities to develop reading skills by looking for word patterns

Preparation: Print off sufficient quantities of the Red Riding Hood Word Search. To frame the activity for the children, you might also like to download the Red Riding Hood PowerPoint

Instructions:

1. Share the story of Little Red Riding Hood with the pupils – if you can, include the vocabulary in the Word Search. Check for recall and understanding.
2. If you want to frame the activity for the children, show them the Red Riding Hood PowerPoint. What can they see in the picture? How does it help to tell the story?
3. Tell the children that they're going to look for some words from the story. Distribute the Red Riding Hood Word Search – with the children working either in pairs or individually.
4. Explain that all the words read horizontally (from left to right), vertically (from top to bottom) or diagonally (from left to right), and some letters are used more than once. Then it's over to the pupils!
5. The activity also contains a version of the Word Search that's just for you – in which all the words are clearly highlighted!

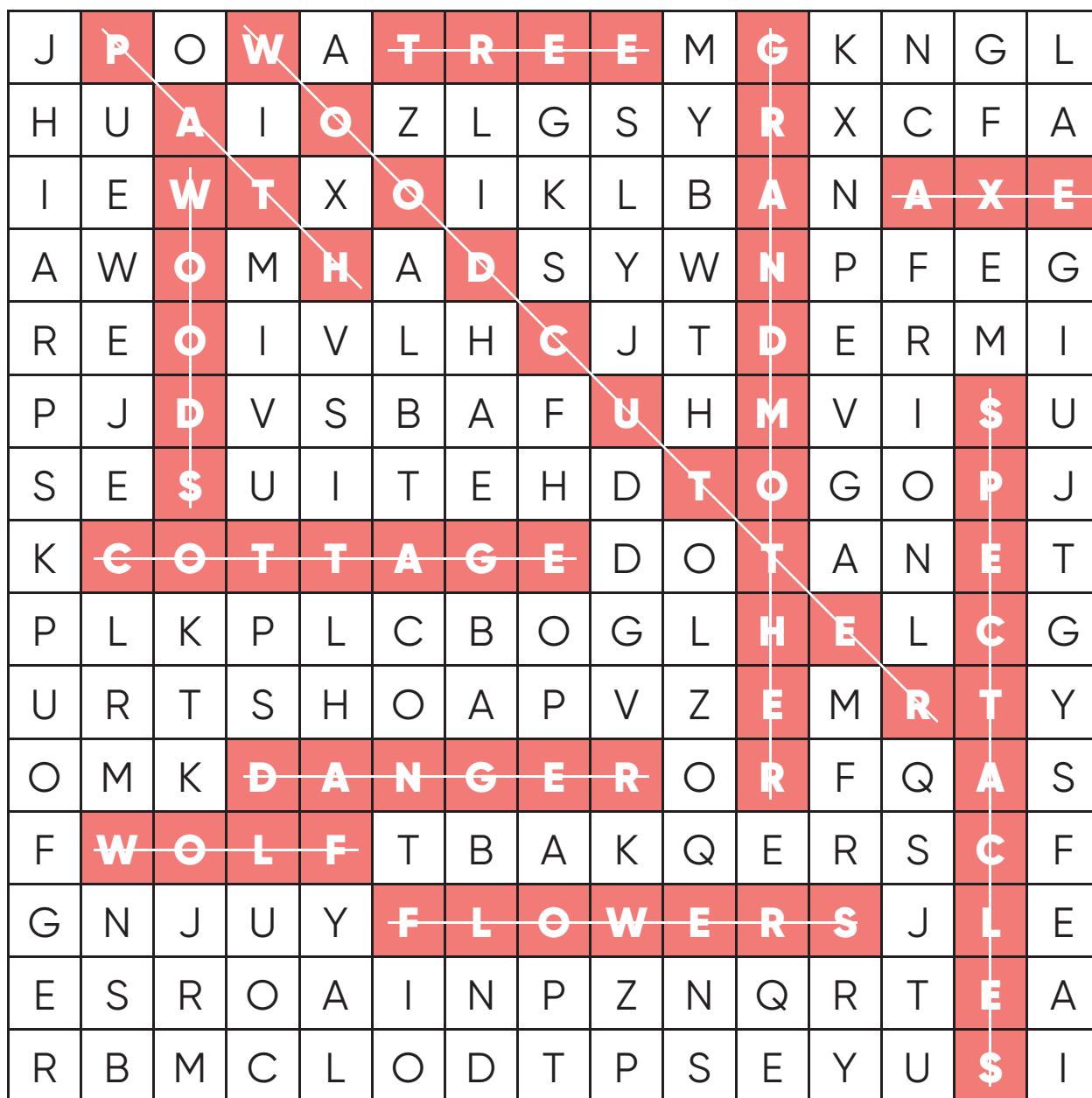
